



Here are some highlights of exhibits, interactive displays and artifacts you will experience at the American Police Hall of Fame, the Space Coast's Newest Attraction! Simply follow the arrows and numbered sections on the museum map on the front of this guide.

**1. The Law Enforcement Memorial.** These solid marble walls of engraved names publicly memorialize law enforcement officers that have fallen in the line of duty from across our great nation. This memorial speaks to our hearts as it brings home the reality of the sacrifices these officers made. There is a special area directly outside the Police Memorial that recognizes the "Law Enforcement Officer of the Year," as well.

**2. Saint Michael's Chapel.** A non-denominational place for quiet prayer and reflection.

**3. Auto Alley.** Experience police pursuit vehicles, past, present and futuristic as well as the actual Blade Runner car used in the 1982 movie starring Harrison Ford. Also see many retired motorcycles including an authentic police-issue 1960 Harley Davidson.

**4. Terrorism.** Experience the memorial to the beloved police heroes who perished on America's darkest day, September 11, 2001. Be prepared for this moving exhibit where you can touch part of a plane and debris from the World Trade Center building. The terrorism section also includes exhibits on the Oklahoma City Bombing, the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games bombing, and showcases the latest night vision equipment, guns and non-lethal forms of protection.

**5. Segway.** Check out the newest and coolest way to patrol the downtown street scene on two-wheeled technology!

**6. K9 Exhibit.** This exhibit depicts the many aspects of the use of dogs in law enforcement and equipment used in training and handling. The cruiser of Polk County (Florida) Officer Matt Williams and his K9 partner, Diogi, who were killed in the line of duty on September 28, 2006 is the honored centerpiece of the exhibit.

**7. Crime Lab.** Displays regarding DNA, fingerprinting, composite drawing and an actual crime clock are featured in this section of the museum.

**8. The "North Pole".** See staff members and volunteers wrap birthday and holiday gifts that are sent nationally to police family survivors in memory of their mother or father who died in the line of duty. Thousands of age-appropriate gifts are sent to young survivors each year thanks to the generous donations made to our non-profit program.

**9. Kids Discovery and Dress-Up.** Try on police jackets and hats from a multitude of departments. Design your own badge in our "Badge Factory." Find out when to, and when not to call 911. Take time at the "McGruff" exhibit to have fun and learn at the same time!

**10. Wild, Wild West.** See an actual stockade and "tramp chair." Have a seat in the chair, if you dare! This section also includes exhibits on other early forms of holding prisoners.

**11. Gun Range.** Education and training is key to this state-of the art indoor shooting facility. Open to the public for sport as well as police departments and agencies for training.

**12. Gift Shop.** A trip to the Police Museum would not be complete without taking home an official APHF T-shirt, police pin or other memorabilia. Our museum staff will be happy to assist you with any questions about the artifacts for sale.
